DIY snow globe





let's make a DIY snow globe

Want to bring some new life to your old plastic toys around the house? Turn them into a fun art project with this DIY snow globe tutorial. Follow the instructions below to make your own winter wonderland.

supplies needed:

- > peanut butter jar
- plastic toy
- > water
- > sequins and/or glitter
- > 1-2 tbsp. glycerin
- > superglue

what to do:

- **1.** Remove any labels from your peanut butter jar. Scrub the jar clean both inside and out, then let dry.
- 2. Take the lid of the peanut butter jar and glue your toy to the inside of it. If the toy is smaller, feel free to glue a small piece of plastic below the toy to help give it height and then glue that to the lid.
- 3. Take the empty peanut butter jar and fill it with water, then mix in about 1-2 teaspoons of sequins and/or glitter. Once stirred, add in 1-2 tbsp. glycerin.
- 4. Screw the lid onto the jar tightly, feel free to glue the lid on for added security. Flip over and shake for snow effect.
