



paper tulips

Now that spring is in full bloom, it's a great time for your family to get crafty! Bonus: this can be educational too. Do a quick online search about the different parts of a flower and talk about them while creating. Sneaking education into crafts? Genius!

supplies needed:

- tulip template (print it here)
- green paper straws
- scissors
- assorted colors of construction paper
- glue or glue stick
- hole punch (optional)

what to do:

1. Print out the tulip template and cut it out. Trace the tulip onto the paper. Repeat on as many colors as you'd like.
2. Cut out each tulip.
3. Fold the flower accordion style four times, and punch or cut a hole in the center of the template.
4. Unfold the paper and run a straw through the holes.
5. Using green construction paper, cut two leaves for each flower. Glue these to the bottom of each straw, wrapping the ends around the straw.
